Mobile Phone Installation

For Installation from the CD if your phone supports installation of files through infra-red, bluetooth or data cable:

1. Transfer the file "iONu.jar" from the CD onto your mobile phone via infra-red, data cable or bluetooth.
2. Follow the instruction on the screen. Click on "Yes" or "Accept" if prompted for permission to install the application.
3. After installation, most phones will prompt you to open the application. Click "Yes" to start using the software. If your phone do not prompt you, locate the installed application and click on it to run.

For OTA (Over the air) installation if your phone does not support installation of files through infra-red, bluetooth or data cable:

1. Using your web browser of your mobile phone, access to our wap site, <http://wap.qcomgroup.com/ionu/download.htm>, and download the file for "mobile phone".
2. Follow the instruction on the screen. Click on "Yes" or "Accept" if prompted for permission to install the application.
3. After installation, most phones will prompt you to open the application. Click "Yes" to start using the software. If your phone do not prompt you, locate the installed application and click on it to run.

PDA Installation

1. To proceed, please ensure you have Microsoft ActiveSync installed on your computer. (Please visit <http://www.microsoft.com/windowsmobile/activesync/default.aspx> to download.)
2. Connect your PDA onto your computer and ActiveSync will run automatically.
3. Click the file "setup.exe" located in the CD and follow the instruction on your computer screen.
4. Once done, the installation will start on your PDA. You will be prompted for permission to install the application onto your PDA, click "Ok".
5. After installation, a shortcut of iONu will be placed under START>PROGRAMS. Tab on it to run the application. Once started, tab on "iONu v3.xx" to run.
